DIRECTIONS to the Port of Miami (Miami, FL)

- From Miami International Airport (MIA) - Take SR-836 (Dolphin Expressway) east through the toll. Exit at Northeast 2nd Avenue/Biscayne Boulevard and turn right on Biscayne Boulevard (US1). Stay in the left lane to turn left on Northeast 5th Street. Drive across bridge. Follow signs to pier terminal.
- From Fort Lauderdale Airport (FLL) - Take I-95 south to exit 3B to Northeast 8th Street (Port of Miami). Continue forward, it will lead you to the port bridge. Drive across bridge and follow signs to pier terminal.

PARKING: The guest parking areas are located adjacent to the piers. Depending on pier location, there are multi-level garages or, flat open-air lots. Parking garages accept cash, Visa or MasterCard. Flat level lots are cash only. The fee's are: \$12 per day for regular size vehicles; \$24 per day for oversized vehicles.

DIRECTIONS to Port Canaveral Cruise Terminal (Cape Canaveral, FL)

- From Orlando International Airport (MCO): Take Airport Exit 1A to SR 528 Beach Line Expressway East Remain on SR 528 East all the way to Port Canaveral Upon approaching the port area, follow the signs indicating Port Canaveral "A" Cruise Terminals
- From I-95: From North or South on I-95 take the SR 528 Beach Line Expressway East Remain on SR 528 East all the way to Port Canaveral. Upon approaching the port area, follow the signs indicating Port Canaveral "A" Cruise Terminals.

PARKING: Parking is available in the garage or open lot across from Cruise Terminal #10 for \$10 USD per day (subject to change). Payment is made as you enter the facility in cash or Visa or MasterCard credit card.
