**Puerto Vallarta** - Cobblestoned and whitewashed Puerto Vallarta is one of the central Pacific coast's best-known beach resorts. Nestled between palm-covered mountains next to a river and an azure bay, the city boasts a setting as ridiculously picturesque as its white-sand beaches and red-tiled houses of white adobe.

The city has mutated from a sleepy seaside village into an international resort so quickly that it is fashionable to deride its spoilt charms, but it's almost impossible to hold a grudge against its lively beaches, bars, restaurants and galleries.

There are dolphins in the bay year-round, and humpback whales between November and March. Locals insist that if you stand on the seafront in April, you can see giant manta rays leaping into the air during their mating rituals.

This sizeable Jalisco-state city stretches itself languidly along the shoreline of an exceptionally beautiful bay on Mexico's central Pacific coast. Running through the city centre is Río Cuale, which briefly forks around the small Isla Cuale in downtown Puerto Vallarta before emptying itself into the ocean. Just north of the river is Plaza Principal, also called Plaza de Armas, the central public space of what was just a quaint warren of cobblestone streets until a couple of luxury-conscious resorts arrived in the area and invited all their high-rise friends over for a non-stop concreting party. Edging around the square are the two main thoroughfares of Morelos and Juárez, while running parallel to them along the foreshore is the Malecón, a promenade lined with restaurants, bars and nightclubs.
